Begin by taking the tail of the <u>lead rope</u> around or through a suitable object to tie a horse to. In our example on the right we're going to tie to a pipe fence post.



Take the tail of the rope (from the left side of the post) and cross it underneath the part of the rope going to the horse.

Then, twist the rope on the left side of the post to form a loop.



Next, take the tail of the rope (which is now on the right side of the post) over the part of the rope going to the horse, and push it up through the loop. See the illustration above.
